#### From the Board....

Update on the sale of the Hege Douthit Land: The sale has been completed. The total proceeds were \$509,669.55, this is after all closing costs and associated fees. There was an initial distribution to Macedonia Moravian Church of \$10,193.39, which was sent assuming this money was invested all year and we would have received 2% dividends. Clemmons Moravian Church also received the same amount with the remainder being deposited into the Hege Douthit Memorial Fund that is currently invested with the Moravian Ministries Foundation. We receive quarterly distributions from the account.

We are planning a Blue Grass Community Dinner in February...look for more details in the future.

We are currently gathering estimates on a replacement heating unit that begun to experience a leak.

We are prayerfully looking forward to 2020.
